As you know this past year has had a devastating effect on the council's finances. There is now a newly created chapter of The Catholic War Veterans of America affiliated with St. Anne's Knights of Columbus #2429. It is St. Anne's Chapter #1979. In order to offset the ever-increasing expenses of running the building, we will be amending the charter of the Columbian Club of Queens Village by transferring title to the St. Anne's Catholic War Veterans Building Corporation in order to provide us with significant financial advantages. The council property would be owned by the Catholic War Veterans Building Corporation.

Nearly every member of the Catholic War Veterans chapter is a St. Anne's Knights of Columbus member. Being affiliated with the Catholic War Veterans will afford us these substantial financial advantages. We are holding a vote on these changes at the second meeting of St. Anne's K of C Council #2429 on September 23rd 2021.
